Cliff falls, Slippery Rocks

Who is at risk?

All visitors and staff

Controls:

- Safety brief given to all visitors at the start of each session
- Visitors instructed to wear suitable sturdy footwear
- Visitors instructed to stay on pathways
- Training given to staff before sessions are taken
- Pathways and walkways well maintained and kept clear
- Groups supervised closely by trained staff at all times
- Mobile telephone carried by Feadon Farm staff at all times
- Cliff walk - Groups use only set footpaths only. The section of cliff that is walked is maintained by Cornwall Council
- First Aid Kits carried by Feadon Farm Staff at All times

Severity: High **Likelihood:** Medium **Risk Factor:** Medium

- Group briefed not to touch or pick up any wild creatures unless supervised by wildlife rangers

Severity: Medium **Likelihood:** Low **Risk Factor:** Low

Zoonoses

Who is at risk?

All visitors and staff

Controls:

- Safety Brief given to all visitors at the start of each session
- Supervised hand washing enforced at the end of each session, at break & meal times
- Antibacterial gel issued between and after animal handling as an additional measure. Gel conforms to BS EN 1500
- All areas kept as free from animal waste as possible
- All areas regularly cleaned & disinfected
- All animals pens regularly cleaned & disinfected
- All animals' daily health checked. Any animals at risk of being unwell immediately removed from public contact
- No eating or drinking in animal areas
- All animals vaccinations kept up to date
- Group advised not to touch animals not under the care of Feadon Farm staff
